Within this framework:

- **Respect for Children's Rights:**

- **Prohibition of Child Labor:**
We strictly prohibit the employment of child labor in our facilities and expect the same sensitivity from our business partners.
- **Safe and Supportive Environments:**
Our establishment provides social environments that contribute to children's development and allow them to express their thoughts and emotions freely. Areas like the Kids Club prioritize the safety and happiness of children.
- **Employee Training:**
We provide regular training to our employees on identifying and preventing child exploitation and protecting children's rights. These programs aim to increase awareness and ensure our staff is well-informed about safeguarding children.
- **Safety in Activities:**
We ensure that all activities involving children are supervised by adults. High-level safety measures are implemented during these events, providing parents with reliable and trustworthy services.
- **Responsiveness to Suspicious Situations:**
Any suspicious situations involving children are promptly reported to hotel management and, if necessary, to the relevant authorities. We act swiftly and decisively in the event of any violations.
- **Awareness and Support:**
We organize training sessions to raise awareness of children's rights and actively participate in and support projects aimed at fostering sensitivity in society.
